

# Essay Competition

## on Landscape Architecture in Atlantic Canada

The purpose of the APALA Essay Competition is to promote design writing, increase public understanding of the relevance of landscape architecture in the Atlantic region, and to communicate to the general public what it is that landscape architects do.

### ESSAY TOPIC

The essay should discuss the significance of an example of landscape architecture located within Atlantic Canada. The project may be (but is not limited to) an example of urban design, site planning, storm water management, restoration, conservation, parks and recreation planning, green infrastructure or private or residential planning and design.

The essay should describe how the design has successfully addressed the needs of the site, the users and the environmental context.

### ELIGIBILITY

APALA members in any membership category and any student currently enrolled in an accredited landscape architecture program in Canada is eligible to participate.

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- An original essay of 1,250-1,500 words
- Supporting photos, graphics and/or illustrations (minimum 1)
- A completed application form
- For student applicants, verification of enrollment in an accredited landscape architecture program.

Submission Deadline: March 31, 2019  
2019 Award Announcement: late-April 2019

### AWARD

The author of the winning essay will be awarded **\$1,000**.
